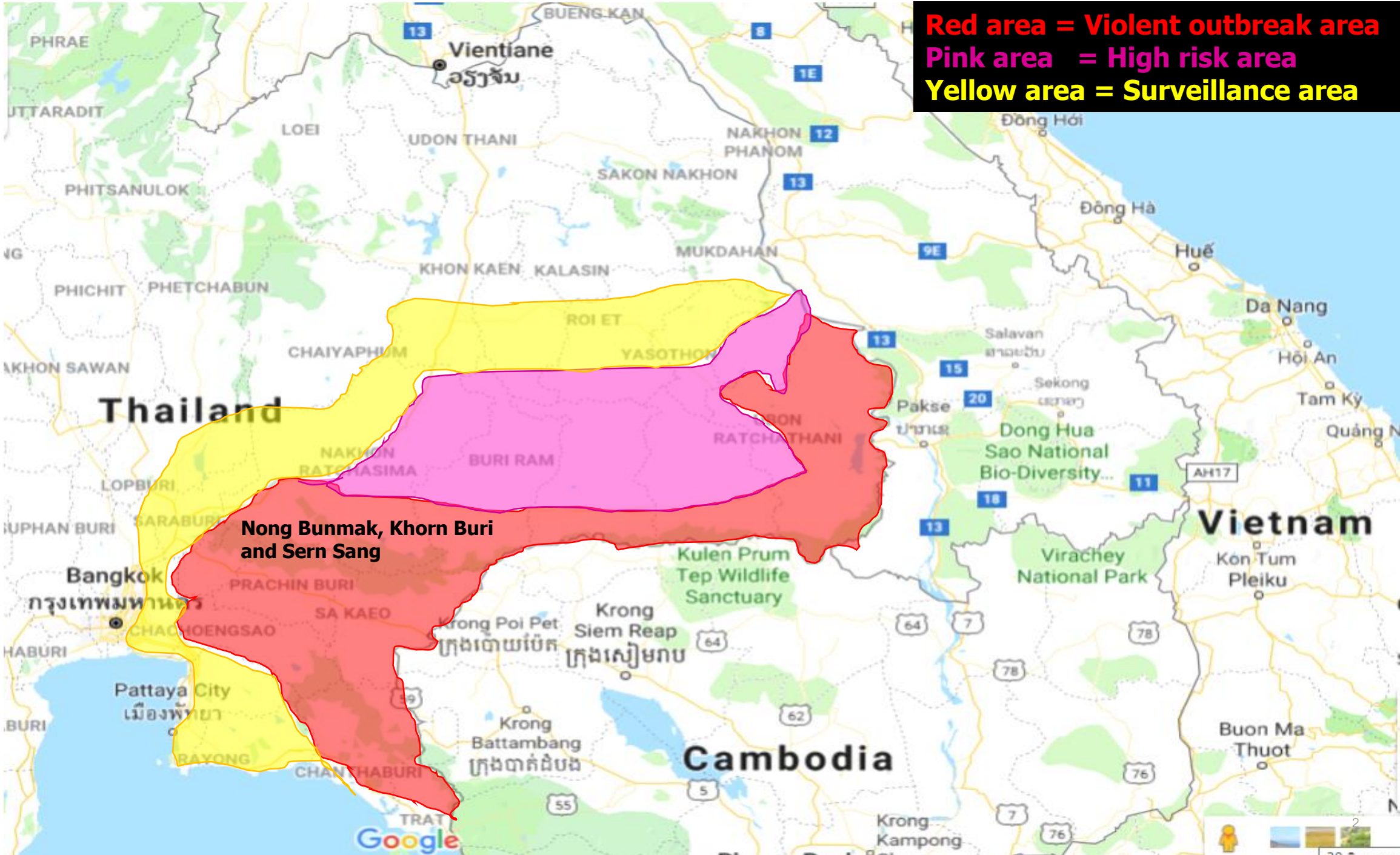

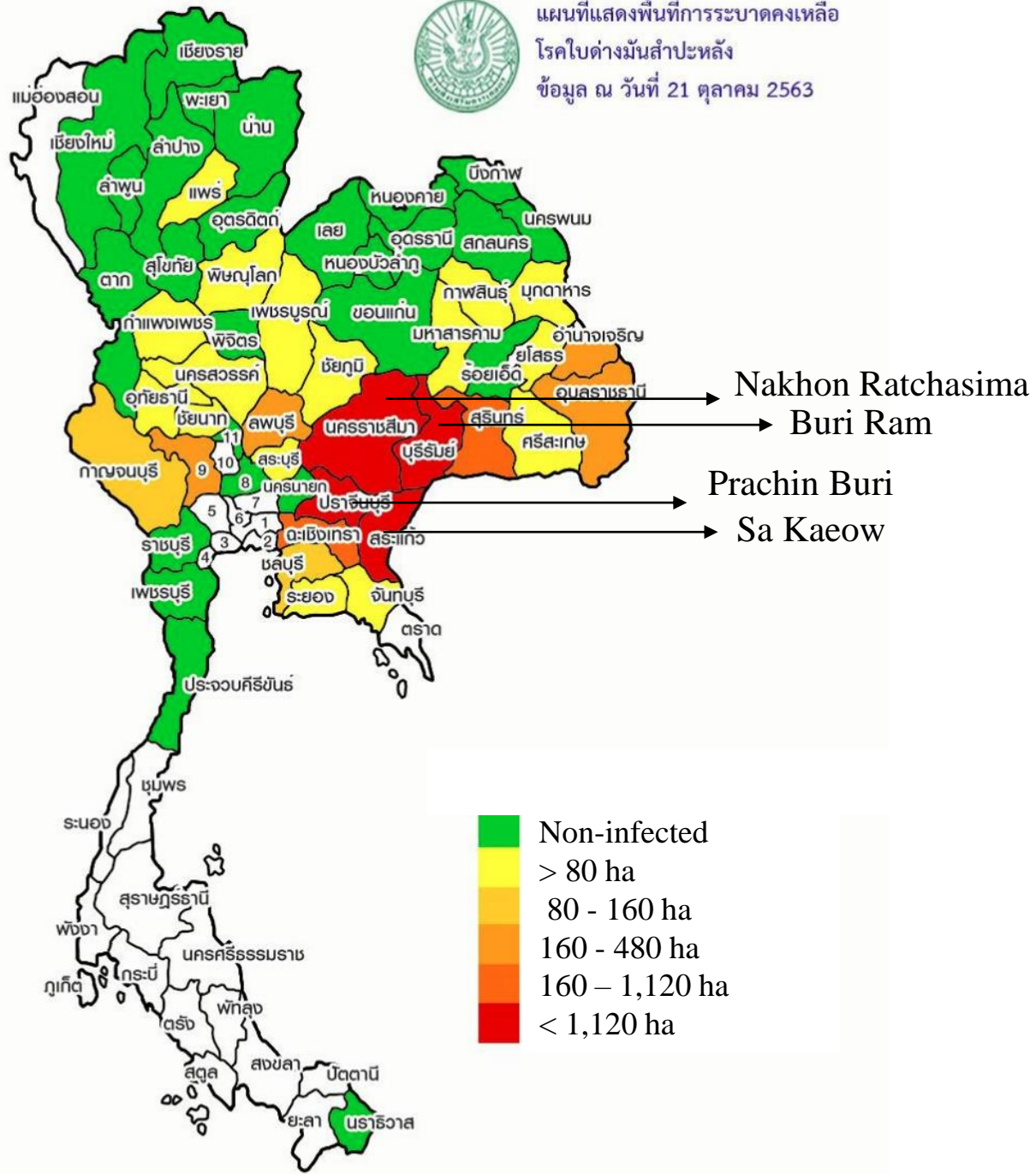


Red area = Violent outbreak area

ข้อมูล ณ วันที่ 21 ตุลาคม 2563

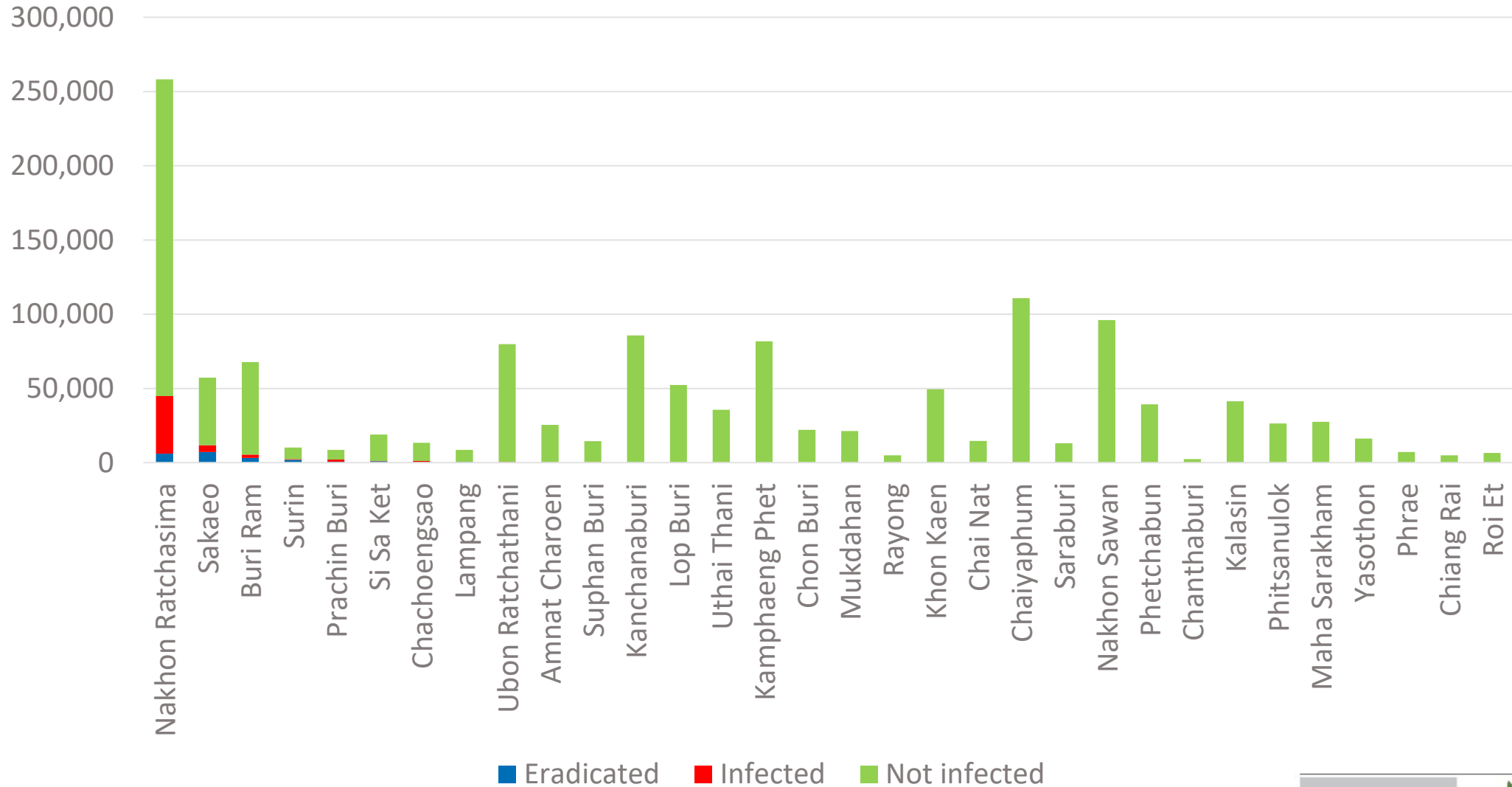


CMD Situation in Thailand

- Cumulative infected area 32 provinces, ~ 71,742 ha

The Commerce Ministry will propose that the cabinet endorse 1.4 billion baht in funding to tackle a widespread disease threatening the tapioca crop.

Commerce Minister Jurin Laksanawisit, who chaired yesterday's meeting of the cassava policy and management committee, said members agreed to ask the cabinet to consider and approve the budget to address the cassava mosaic disease (CMD) present in 26 provinces, up from 22 at the start of the year.

The funding scheme is scheduled to run from November 2020 to Sept 30, 2021.
